




Function 1	Speaking (4)
Grade	2 (A1)
Function	Asking someone's name
Skills	Speaking (warm-up) Listening for specific information Speaking (accuracy, fluency)
Duration	30 minutes
Materials Required	A small ball Worksheet in Appendix A A puppet Tapescript 2.1
Aims	To recognize when someone introduces himself or herself To ask questions to learn someone's name To introduce themselves in a simple way
Procedures	1. The teacher brings a small ball to the class and shows the picture in Appendix A. S/he introduces "Throw the ball" game and tells her/his name to the class. After that, s/he throws the ball to one of the students and asks him/her "What is your name?". The teacher directs the student who gets the ball to tell his/her name and then to throw the ball to another student in the class and ask "What's your name?". 2. The teacher gives out the worksheet in Appendix A and asks the students to listen to the Tapecsript 2.1. Then s/he wants them to write the names of the children under the correct picture. 3. After the students finish the listening activity in Appendix A, the teacher asks the students to work in pairs and introduce themselves to each other.



Function	Greeting and meeting people
Skills	Speaking (warm-up) Listening for specific information Speaking (accuracy, fluency)
Duration	30 minutes
Materials Required	Worksheet in Appendix A Tapescript 2.2 Workheet in Appendix B
Aims	To recognize simple expressions about greeting and meeting someone To use everday expressions about greeting and meeting someone To ask questions to find out how they are doing
Procedures	 The teacher gives out the worksheet in Appendix A. S/he starts the activity showing the pictures to the class. The teacher asks the students to match the pictures with the greeting phrases in Appendix A. The teacher asks the students to complete the missing parts according to the Tapescript 2.2. The teacher asks the students to listen to the Tapescript 2.2 again and act out the dialogue with their partners. The teacher gives out the speaking worksheet in Appendix B. S/he asks the students to look at the pictures and complete the dialogue with the given expressions. After the students complete the dialogue, the teacher asks them to act out the dialogue. In Speaking b, the teacher asks the students to make dialogues with the given expressions. S/he encourages the students to act out their dialogues. The teacher draws the students' attention on the Spotlight. In Project section, the teacher asks the students to make a puppet. S/he asks them to make dialogues.
