



LEISURE ACTIVITIES AROUND THE WORLD

Do you know what the most popular leisure time activity is? What do we do in our free time?

According to our survey, people aged 15-65 prefer watching TV in their free time. The second most popular answer is reading a book. Online video games take the third place in this list. However, when we consider we are living in a digital era which our children are born into, it is quite probable that it will take the first place in a decade or so.

In the survey, the participants' ages, jobs and favourite free time activities are asked. The least common answers are spending time with family, doing exercise, extreme sports, hobbies and related activities. The results show that the answer to this question depends mostly on the age of the person. Job, country, climate and economical reasons are the other important variables. As we mentioned, in choosing a leisure time activity, age is the most important determiner. For example, while young people prefer surfing the Internet, playing video games, doing outdoor activities and hanging out with friends, adults prefer watching TV, doing indoor activities and spending time with their families. Job is also another factor that affects the result. People who have tiring jobs prefer spending their free time with indoor activities such as watching films or sports programmes on TV



and listening to music. On the other hand, people who have to sit long hours while they are working or students who have plenty of free time prefer attending sports activities such as swimming, jogging etc. When we take the results into account, the facilities of the country or city also play an important role on people's choices. A place by the sea offers its citizens to do water sports. Climate affects the possible answers, too. For instance, in Canada, most people enjoy ice hockey or in Sweeden, people do winter sports while in Greece, people go swimming and fishing. In big cities, people usually go to cafés and restaurants or they go shopping while in small villages people have limited options.

To sum up, leisure time activities widely differ from one person to another and it is determined by the age, job, geography, climate as much as the personal interests.



SIGNS IN THE CAVES

Last summer, we made an excursion to see the cave paintings of Spain, especially the most famous one of them, the Cave of Altamira. It was the most thrilling experience I've ever had.



Why drink enough water every day?

Water helps your body to function in a proper way and to get rid of wastes completely. It also protects your kidney from forming stones.

Your body loses its water content through sweating, breathing and the activities of the urinary system. The amount of water it loses also depends on the climate you live in; in other words, you need to consume more water if you are living in a hot climate.



In order to stay healthy, you ought to replace the amount of the fluid you lose. Dehydration occurs when your body can't get enough liquids. When you keep your body dehydrated for a while, it can't convey sufficient blood to your organs, which is really dangerous.

Should you drink only water to keep hydrated?

You can stay hydrated through consuming all kinds of liquids. You can get enough fluid by drinking beverages you normally drink every day such as tea, coffee, fruit juice, or soda. However, the wisest choice is water as it has no calorie or sugar content. Your food intake also adds up to your daily needed water consumption. Many vegetables like lettuce, or fleshy fruits like melons contain a great deal of water.

Manufacturers have been using additives in food for over fifty years to strengthen its appearance and taste. However, are we sure that they are using the healthy ones?

Nowadays, we eat processed food instead of fruit and vegetables. Processed food includes many additives that threaten our health seriously. For instance, aspartame, the artificial sweetener, is regarded as a harmful substance. It can be found in fizzy drinks, desserts, sugar-free drinks and food. Using aspartame in food can especially cause diseases like diabetes, Parkinson's, Alzheimer, dizziness and migraine. Fructose and glucose syrup are artificial sweeteners used in bread, candies, cereals and goodies. They are known to raise cholesterol and sugar levels in blood. Trans fat, which is the most commonly used additive, extends the shelf life of products. It may exist in fast food, baked products, chips, crackers and other numerous goods. ALFRED BERNHARD NOBEL

Have you ever wondered why we call the Nobel Prize as it is? Who is Nobel?

With his full name Alfred Bernhard Nobel is a Swedish inventor who was born in 1833 in Stockholm and died in 1896, at the age of sixty three.

He was the son of a rich industrialist, inventor and engineer and learned a lot from his father as he had a lively intellectual curiosity from his childhood. When he was nine, they moved to St. Petersburg. When he reached sixteen, he was not only a competent chemist, but also able to speak French, English and Russian fluently. At the age of nineteen, he went to Paris and the USA to study chemistry. When he returned, he started to work for his father and made experiments on explosives. He invented the blasting cap, dynamite, blasting gelatine, artificial silk and leather... He had three hundred and fifty patents in many countries.



The invention of dynamite has led many benefits like building roads and railways, blasting tunnels and cutting canals. Despite its benefits, people still called Nobel as 'merchant of death'. When his brother Ludvig died in France, French journalists confused him with Alfred and reported it with a headline "Le merchand de la mort est mort!" (The merchant of death is dead). This must have affected him deeply and inspired him to donate his money for the establishing the world's most prestigious prizes, including the Nobel Peace Prize.

Today, there are six kinds of Nobel Prizes which are given in Literature, Economy, Physiology or Medicine, Physics, Chemistry and Peace. The Nobel Prize Award ceremonies take place at the Nobel Institute in Oslo and Stockholm every year by Swedish and Norwegian institutions and the winners are usually announced at the beginning of October.
