Chinese Great Wall

The 1 _____ of the wall is to protect the boundaries of twenty separate Chinese dynasties. This wall is a small defence set. It was later 2 _____ by Qin Shi Huang, the first Chinese ruler, as a completely impenetrable wall. Thus, the attack of the Mongol and Turkish 3 _____ coming from the north to Qin Shi Huang's country will be 4 _____. Many historians have different views on the 5 _____ of the defence wall, but the common view is that the war 6 _____ of neighbouring dynasties captured during the war use it. And the 7 _____ must be ruled by this defence wall from all sides of the world. It is also seen as a defence wall in the history of the Great Wall of China. The reason for this is that there are 8 _____ places, trenches and 9 _____ every 200 meters on the wall. Not all of the Chinese Great Wall has a great example of workmanship and 10 _____. On the contrary, some of the walls were built with brick, while others were built with light building materials. It is usually built as 4-6 meters in height, 7 meters in base thickness and 6 meters in ceiling thickness, that is, the upper part of the wall.
