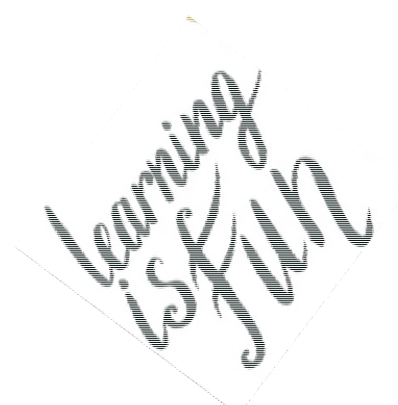

Expressing Preferences

- We use **'prefer'** to express our preferences.
- We use the **'-ing'** form of the verb after **prefer**.

Examples :

- I prefer pop music. → I prefer **listening** to pop music.
- Sheila prefers travel books. → Sheila prefers **reading** travel books.

- We use **'to'** when we compare two things.

Examples :

- We prefer camping to chess. → We prefer going camping to playing chess.
- Gibson prefers music to books. → Gibson prefers listening to music to reading books.

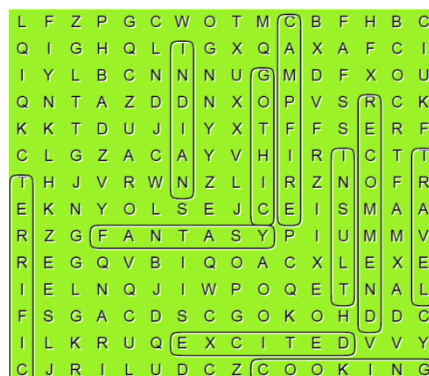
